Successfully deployed the open-source Medusa.js backend on AWS ECS using a fully automated CI/CD pipeline with Terraform and GitHub Actions, ensuring scalable, reliable, and production-ready infrastructure.

Implementation:

- Developed modular Terraform to provision AWS infrastructure: VPC, subnets, IGW, RT, ALB, ECS Fargate, PostgreSQL (RDS), and CloudWatch. .
- Configured GitHub Actions for CI/CD automation: build, push, and deployment workflows.
- Built and pushed optimized multi-stage Docker images (reduced from 1.06 GB to 154 MB) to Docker Hub.
- Set up ECS Task Definitions and Services to deploy the Medusa backend containers.
- Implemented secure access and networking using IAM roles, security groups, and environment variables.
- Enabled monitoring and alerting using AWS CloudWatch. .

Challenges Faced & Solutions:

- Admin build error: Resolved by correcting the path and ensuring build execution before server start.
- Database not migrating: Resolved by modifying the RDS parameter group to enable necessary configurations for migration compatibility.
